Strong In Spirit F.A.Q.

(Top 10 Frequently Asked Questions)



- 1. **What is the Strong In Spirit Conference?** A life-changing one day event that will help equip you to live a life that is far stronger, more enjoyable and usable to Jesus Christ.
- 2. **How much does the Strong In Spirit Conference cost?** The cost is \$20 per person or \$30 per family. People in full time ministry and their families get in free.
- 3. **Are there other costs involved in hosting a Conference?** The host church is responsible for Pastor Bruce's transportation, lodging and meals, printing out the Conference Handout, paying for refreshments during breaks and doing any advertising they would like. There are no other costs only benefits.
- 4. **How long does the Conference last?** There is about 6½ hours of teaching. Add breaks and meals to that and it can be scheduled on a Saturday from 9:00am to 5:00pm, or for about 3.5 hours of time each evening over two different days. One popular format is to begin the Conference Friday night and conclude it on Saturday from 9:00am until 1:00pm.
- 5. If my church won't host this, can I host a Conference in my home or other location? Yes.
- 6. **Is there a manual or handout that comes with the Conference?** Yes, at no additional cost.
- 7. Can I buy the "Living The Strong In Spirit Way" book? Yes, for a donation of \$20.
- 8. What is the difference between the Strong In Spirit Conference and Transformation Ministry? They are two separate, 'stand alone' ministries that God has given me to do. The former is for groups of people while the latter is for individuals. The former is to help make believers strong, while the latter is to help heal the broken-heartedness and free believers from the wounds, sins and strongholds of the past and present.
- 9. **Who are you?** I was a pastor for nearly 20 years when God gave me the Strong In Spirit message that so radically changed my life. Shortly after He led me to resign from pastoring and begin this ministry to bring the Strong In Spirit message to the wider body of Christ.
- 10. **What is your mission?** To raise up Strong In Spirit disciples like John the Baptist and Paul the Apostle by liberating, strengthening and transforming disciples who will live out their destinies, co-reign with Christ in life, expand God's kingdom on earth and carry out His works of love. All this is simple Christ-likeness.
